

Tables and Graphs

Tables and graphs text should respect a minimum of 8 pt type size; all captions should be upper and lower-case, centred over 1 column of body text. Use ILLUSTRATION Style.

Illustrations and Photographs

Halftones, minimum of 8 pt type size, captions should be in upper and lower case, centred over 1 column of body text.



For illustrations (images) and tables caption use style ILLUSTRATION. Your image or table must be centred across one column

Paper size A4, 2,2 cm (0,9”) left and right margins; 2cm (0,8”) bottom margin; 3cm (1,2”) top margin.
